



# Damaru

The Damaru, originating from India, is a small two-headed drum that is played by rotating the drum quickly so that the two pellets on the string hit the heads of the drum.

## Materials:

- 2 8-oz paper cups
- 1 sheet of paper
- 15 cm string
- 2 beads
- paint
- glue
- scissors

## Steps

1. **Glue the ends of the paper cups together.**
2. **Trace the circular tops of the cups on the sheet of paper twice.**
3. **Cut out the circles & glue them to the tops of the 2 cups.**
4. **Decorate how you want with paint!**
5. **Add 2 beads to the string & tie knots on either end so the beads don't fall off.**
6. **Wrap & tie the string around the middle of the drum (where you glued the cups together). Glue in place if necessary.**



**Spin & shake back & forth to play!**
